

Author Agreement for UPM 20187, on 21-22 February, 2018

In submitting an abstract for consideration for the UPM Forum, I am responsible for ensuring that work described in the abstract was conducted in accordance with this Agreement. All abstracts submitted are screened to ensure that they meet submission standards:

- Includes practical elements of the application of upstream measurement and production data
- Includes substantive results and recommendations
- Does not promote a commercial product or service
- Significantly contributes to the technical knowledge base of the industry

Should the Work be selected for publication and presentation at the UPM Forum, I commit to attend the UPM Forum (or will ensure one of the authors will attend the UPM Forum) to present the Work orally with an overhead presentation. For simplicity, the word "authors" will be used in the following text in place of "author" or "authors".

On occasion, it may become necessary to solicit additional information from submitters. Failure to reply satisfactorily to a request for additional information constitutes grounds for abstract rejection. While abstracts are evaluated for engineering interest and are citable, the brevity of the abstract precludes rigorous technical review. Thus, abstract acceptance should not be taken as endorsement by the reviewers as validity of the work.

Author Agreement for UPM 2018, on 21-22 February, 2018

Submission of an abstract constitutes a formal agreement and statement by the authors that they have conducted the reported work. Abstracts must be based on results that have not been published in their entirety nationally or internationally, before submission to the UPM Forum. Abstract submission implies an understanding that the authors will receive no remuneration from the UPM Forum.

The written paper and the presentation material presented at the meeting must be substantively identical to that described in the abstract. In particular, the title, authorship, and content must match that in the abstract. No presentation may be given by an individual who is not an author on the abstract.

A review and practice delivery of the presentation under the guidance of a professional presentation coach provided by the UPM Forum is mandatory. The practice presentations will be scheduled during the day before the Forum.

Authors give the UPM Forum, its agents and its representatives the right to use their names, company names, and likenesses in promotional and other material published in relation to the forum.

In making this agreement, it is understood that each author or author employer retains the following rights:

1. All other proprietary rights, such as patent rights
2. The right to post, publish, or re-use in future works of the author's own any portion of the work, without fee, provided that the UPM Forum citation is included.
3. The right to use, post, or publish their own author-versions of preprints and revisions not covered by Administrator's copyright.
4. The right of an employer who originally owned copyright to distribute within its organization copies of the Work by its author-employees.
